

CHRIST's contribution for Covid 19

Summary:

As part of our social responsibility, we have supported following COVID-19 relief activities;

Altogether, we have supported **12331** persons and **1030** families among the vulnerable population in our project areas. This is worth 20 lakhs 34 thousand

- Distributed 1030 survival kits (to vulnerable population) which contains Rice, Aatta, grain, oil etc., benefiting 4120 people in 3 urban slums and 81 villages where we have our projects (in Chhattisgarh and Karnataka).
- Distributed protection Kits (Masks, soaps and hand sanitiser) to the families of CSA sponsored children in L R Nagar and Janaki Ram slums and the villages in our project area.
- 5000 masks were distributed in Kainakary, Alappuzha district, Kerala with the support of local panchayat.
- Provided resource support to ASVAS NGO for providing food materials for 500 families.
- Our field facilitators in the villagers are Extending support to local self-government systems like BBMP, PHCs and panchayaths by creating awareness about COVID-19 and supporting the relief work activities
- Arranged a makeshift shelter for migrants at Bomnahalli Boys hostel .
- Our Niravilpuzha tribal project has supported 1500 tribal families with various benefits
- Awareness building through CHRIST community development project system,

- Among our community development projects, we have provided COVID-19 relief support to 34 tribal villages in Kanker district, Chhattisgarh State, 11 villages in Jamkhandi, 22 villages in Kolar, 14 villages in Hoskote, Bangalore rural district and 3 slums in Bangalore.
